Baltinglass GAA Club is planning to carry out substantial works on the 'Back Pitches' of our Grounds at Newtownsaunders, Baltinglass.

The proposed works consists of:

- → Drainage Works on the total area covering our current 'Back Pitches'
- → Levelling of the total area covering our current 'Back Pitches'

Then:

- → Creating two new pitches on the newly drained and levelled ground.
 Due to the huge increase in Juvenile and Adult Player Membership, our Club needs these two new pitches to facilitate the huge number of games being played on our grounds.
- → Creating a 1 KM+ walkway around the circumference of our full grounds which will be an excellent amenity. (*Marked in light blue on the attached drawings.*)
- → Building a 'Kicking Wall' and Skills Area when complete this will be a great asset to further develop the skills of Gaelic Football with all our players Male & Female, Juveniles & Adults.
- → Building a Roadway around the back of the current stand and going out our second gateway onto the road. This will accommodate a circular one-way traffic system and improve the safety of traffic movement at our grounds. (Marked in green on the attached drawings.)

To achieve the completion of this ambitious Development Program we need to ensure we have the Funding robustly planned and delivered <u>before we commence works.</u>
